Cafeteria Charge Policy

K-8 Students will be allowed to charge 3 meals. When a child reaches this limit they will not be allowed to charge again until the charges have been paid. If a child has charged 3 meals and needs a school meal and does not have money to purchase it, he or she will be given a peanut butter sandwich, carrot sticks, fruit and white milk at no charge. This alternative meal is a temporary solution and not for daily use.

Second meals and All Cart items cannot be charged. Students who owe charges will not be permitted to purchase items from the snack bar until the charges have been paid.

If a free and reduced meal application has been submitted, the Parents/Guardian of the student are responsible for the cost of their children's meals until the application has been received and approved.

The food service department will send out weekly phone calls and emails to the Parents and Guardians of students who owe meal charges.
