CAFETERIA CHARGE POLICY

Adults and High School Students are not allowed to charge.

K-8 Students will be allowed to charge 2 meals. When a child reaches this limit they will not be allowed to charge again until the charges have been paid. If a child has 2 meals charged and needs a school meal and does not have money to purchase it, he or she will be given a peanut butter sandwich, carrot sticks, fruit and milk at no charge. This alternative meal is a temporary solution for when a child forgets his or her lunch money and is not for daily use.

Second meals and All a Cart items cannot be charged. Students who owe charges will not be permitted to purchase items from the snack bar until the charges have been paid.

If a free and reduced meal application has been submitted, Parents are responsible for the cost of their children's meals until it is received and approved.

The food service department will send out weekly phone calls and emails to the parent of students that owe meal charges.
