The goal of Galena Park ISD Student Nutrition Services is to provide quality nutritious meals for the students and staff each school day. Meals are designed to meet the tastes of the students while following USDA guidelines for nutritional content. Low fat and reduced sodium recipes and items are included in our menus as well as whole grain products. For more information, please contact Student Nutrition Services.

Galena Park ISD participates in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs. **Applications for Free or Reduced-Price meals are available throughout the school year at the school office, in the cafeteria or at the Student Nutrition Services office. You will need to complete only one application per household. Include all students in your household who are enrolled in any Galena Park ISD school. New applications must be completed each School Year.**

Parents are encouraged to Prepay for their child's meal and extra items to speed service. Student transactions can be printed at your request. Please contact your Cafeteria Manager for more details. Money for prepayment may be sent to the Cafeteria Manager as often as necessary in a sealed envelope. If sending a check, please make it payable to Galena Park ISD Student Nutrition Services. Please write the student's name and keypad number on the front of the envelope or check to ensure credit to the proper account. Students will be notified when the account reaches a low balance.

At Elementary school cafeterias, students may charge up to 3 lunches. Students who come to eat after having exceeded their charge limit will be offered an alternate meal of a peanut butter/jelly or a cheese sandwich and milk. The Student Nutrition cashier will send a Student Meal Account Notice envelope with the student when his/her account balance is low or has reached a negative balance. Cashiers also notify students as they come to the serving line that their balance is low. Your student's account balance can be accessed for review by the cafeteria manager, by the cashier, or by the Student Nutrition office staff if requested by the Parent or student. Middle School or High School campuses allow only one meal to be charged.

En la cafetería de las escuelas primarias, los límites de crédito para los estudiantes, son 3 comidas. A los estudiantes que vengan a comer después de haber excedido su límite de crédito se les ofrecerá una comida alternativa de crema de cacahuete/mermelada o un sándwich de queso y leche. La cajera de Nutrición Estudiantil enviará un sobre de Notificación de la Cuenta de Comida del Estudiante con el estudiante cuando el balance en su cuenta esté bajo o tenga un balance negativo. Las cajeras también notifican a los estudiantes cuando su balance esté bajo al pasar por la línea para servirse. La encargada de la cafetería, la cajera, o el personal de la oficina de Nutrición Estudiantil pueden tener acceso al balance de la cuenta de su hijo(a) si el padre o el estudiante lo pide. En las escuelas de secundaria y preparatoria, se les permitirá a los estudiantes obtener en crédito solo una comida.
