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5661 DISTRICT WELLNESS POLICY

The Honeoye Falls-Lima School Board will comply with all applicable laws and regulations to promote a school environment that promotes students' health, well-being, and ability to learn, by fostering healthy eating and physical activity before, during, and after the school day. This wellness policy outlines the District's approach to ensuring environments and opportunities for all students to practice healthy eating and physical activity behaviors throughout the school day while minimizing commercial distractions. This wellness policy applies to all students, staff, and schools in the District.

The District's local Wellness Committee is composed of representative members such as students, parents, leaders in food and exercise including representatives from Food Services, health & physical education teachers, administrators, and other District employees. The Superintendent or his designee will provide oversight of the committee. The Wellness Committee is authorized to formulate practices and procedures consistent with federal and state requirements as they might change from time to time for consideration by the Superintendent or his/her designees to be adopted as regulations for the District and posted on the District's website and in Food Services. Such committee shall provide minutes reporting its meetings and activities to those overseeing the committee at least quarterly.
